## AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT BETWEEN TWO SIDES SAUDIAN SIDE  
HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS PRINCE MOHAMMED BIN  
NAIF BIN ABDULAZIZ AL SAUD OF SAUDI ARABIA,  
AND MONGOLIAN SIDE THE MINISTRY OF NATURE AND  
THE ENVIRONMENT OF MONGOLIA

1. The Mongolian side shall receive in Mongolia His Royal Highness Prince together with his accompanying persons for 60 days each year under an Agreement established for a period of 10 years starting from 1994.

During His Royal Highness Prince's visit in Mongolia, the Mongolian side shall render all possible assistance and provide him with professional guide who knows well the Gobi land, service men, Arabic and English language interpreters, patrol and other necessary items.

Also the *Ministry of Nature and the Environment* will provide all necessary assistance for the Prince and his delegation during the trip for trapping and bringing away falcons.

2. His Royal Highness Prince shall begin from 1994 making U.S.\$ 2,000,000 (U.S.\$ Two Million only) contribution to the Mongolian Fund for Environmental protection for the purpose of rare birds in Mongolia and establishing furthermore a centre for their protection. In this regard the Prince will give at first in 1994 U.S.\$ 200,000 (U.S.\$ Two hundred Thousand only) to the Fund as his pre-contribution and he will give in 1995 U.S.\$1,000,000 (U.S.\$ One Million only), this contribution will be for 6 years as this Agreement U.S.\$ 200,000 (U.S.\$ Two Hundred Thousand only) every year.

3. According to an Agreement, His Royal Highness Prince shall receive each year 3-5 persons from Mongolia at his own expense and make them get acquainted with the operation and working experience of the Bustard Protection and Production centre in Saudi Arabia.

4. 5 to 10 Bustards shall be given each year to Mongolia from the Bustard Study Centre of Saudi Arabia.

5. The Mongolian side shall permit His Royal Highness Prince to have falcons seized and brought out from Mongolia under condition that all the documents required under the law and regulation of Mongolia are completed in due form like the permission of hunting, permission taking out the falcons to Saudi Arabia, medical certificates and Customs clearance. The numbers of bird to be seized and brought out will be up to 80 (eighty) falcons every year during this Agreement.

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN TWO SIDES SAUDIAN SIDE

AND MONGOLIAN SIDE THE MINISTRY OF NATURE AND

1. The Mongolian side shall receive in Mongolia His Royal Highness Prince together with his accompanying persons for 60 days each year under an agreement established for a period of 10 years starting from 1996.

During His Royal Highness Prince's visit in Mongolia, the Mongolian side shall render all possible assistance and provide him with professional guide who knows well the Gobi land, service men, Arabic and English language interpreters, petrol and other necessary items.

Also the Ministry of Nature and the Environment will provide all necessary assistance for the Prince and his delegation during the trip for trapping and bringing away falcons.

2. His Royal Highness Prince shall begin from 1996 making US \$ 2,000,000 (US \$ Two Million only) contribution to the Mongolian Fund for Environmental protection for the purpose of rare birds in Mongolia and establishing furthermore a centre for their protection. In this regard the Prince will give at first in 1996 US\$ 200,000 (US\$ Two hundred Thousand only) to the Fund as his pre-contribution and he will give in 1995 US\$ 1,000,000 (US\$ One Million only), this contribution will be for 6 years as this agreement US\$ 200,000 (US\$ Two Hundred Thousand only) every year.

3. According to an Agreement, His Royal Highness Prince shall receive each year 3-5 persons from Mongolia at his own expense and make them get acquainted with the operation and working experience of the Bustard Protection and Production centre in Saudi Arabia.

4. 5 to 10 Bustards shall be given each year to Mongolia from the Bustard Study Centre of Saudi Arabia.

5.
